## Presidents Report

### Dear Members

It's been a quiet time over the last month so not a lot to report about, just a few items of note; Due to a few question from members I sent an email to Natcom regarding the insurance cover afforded to our members when we are on a ride etc to find to what extent the coverage is, the response is as follows

Dear Helena,

Due a few requests from the members to clarify the insurance cover afforded to the members of the Ulysses Club Inc by NATCOM when on club rides.

The questions are as follows,

1. What is a sanctioned Ride i.e. does it have to be on the ride calendar? **Any ride that is sanctioned by the Branch Committee and / or is under the umbrella of the Branch.**
2. How is the insurance cover effected when the Branch has an impromptu ride? **As long as the Committee / Rides Leader knows of the ride; the Ride Leader is covered (for proven negligence); the gathering at a venue is covered by the Club's insurance (but should anything untoward occur (and be proven) and a claim was to go to court the venue licensee could also be accountable as well as the person who caused the problem).**

3. What is covered by the insurance cover? **The gathering venue of the members should anything untoward happen and be proven.**
4. What is not covered by the insurance cover? **Individual members/riders are not covered; we would assume that they are all trained and licensed riders; they would travel at the speeds and to the conditions of the road; their bikes would be roadworthy.**  
  
**Their vehicles are not covered but rather by their own personal insurance, third party insurance and they would have their own private health insurance; does not cover personal injury or anything relating to the member's bike. It does not cover games or the use of anything mechanical.**
5. How is the ride coordinator role and corner markers responsibilities effected by the insurance cover? **The rides leader responsible for a sanctioned ride is covered by our Insurance policy (for proven negligence only); we do not have ride rules and we do not tell members how to ride; the Rides Leader is not responsible for the way Riders handle their motorcycles; individual riding abilities nor is he/she responsible for the road conditions (although a reconnaissance of the route could be carried out prior to a ride if any there is any doubt)**
6. Do the rides to the AGM come under the insurance cover? **NO!**
